


## Youth Technology Network Wraps Up a Dynamic Summer of STEM Camps



Youth Technology Network (YTN) proudly completed another successful summer of hands-on STEM camps in August, partnering with the Fairfax County Park Authority, Loudoun County Parks and Recreation, Falls Church Community Center, and the Virginia Refugee Student Achievement Project. Across these partnerships, YTN delivered 25 engaging camps that served more than 370 campers ages 8–18 and their families.
